INSTRUCTIONS

Ignite Imaginations advise that this activity should be carried out under the supervision of an adult.
When cutting, always make sure you ask an adult to help.

- 1 With the ruler & pencil, draw two 3D skyscraper buildings. Use steps 2- 5 if it helps:
- 2 Use one edge of the coloured paper as one of the long sides of a rectangle and then draw two lines to make up the other long side (22-25cm high) and the top of the rectangle.
- 3 Now draw a short diagonal line from the top of that rectangle sloping downwards.
- 4 Then, from that point, use the ruler to draw a second vertical line down to the bottom of the page. This makes the first building.
- 5 Repeat the method in steps 2-4 to create a shorter building that looks as if it is behind the first one.
- 6 Add square, rectangular, circular or arched windows to each building.
- 7 Go over the pencil lines carefully with black ink pen, filling in some windows to provide contrast. Think about things that you could draw onto the windowsills or on the side of the building (flowers, pets, superheroes etc).
- 8 Now use the white paper & ink pen, to draw a tall skyscraper of your own design. It could be a building you know, a building you would like to visit or completely original.
- 9 When you have finished, ask an adult to help cut it out and glue to the coloured paper, then admire your architectural masterpiece!
