
## Going on Safari with our artist Annie

- Watercolour
- Magazines
- Tissue paper
- · String or ribbon

## **Safari Bunting**

Step by Step

#### Create a triangular template

I used A5 paper (half a sheet of A4) folded in half lenghth ways and drew a line from the central point at the bottom to the top two outside edges. Cut this out and you have an elongated triangle template.



Draw around your template and cut out the triangles.

You can use any card for this, I used recycled packaging such as cereal boxes (make sure one side is plain).





#### Get creative

Now the fun part! Use whatever art materials you have to create animal patterns on your triangles. I have used wax resist (wax crayon/oil pastel with watercolour or watered down paint over the top) irregular circles in green, brown and yellow for crocodile; light/ dark brown and orange/ yellow for leopard skin;

Collage tissue paper in irregular squares for giraffe and felt tip irregular stripes for zebra and tiger.



#### Attach it together

You can use any string, ribbon to attach the triangles together. This can be done with tape, staples or by making holes and threading through the string or ribbon leaving spare at each end to make a loop or tie it up.




Show it off...by putting it up somewhere all the family can see, or even in your window!

### **Safari Bird Mask**



- Print this mask template (on thin card or stick the paper print out onto card) and cut out around the edges and the eyes.
- Decorate with pens, pencils and collage
- Carefully make holes on either side as marked.
- Take a length of elastic to fit around your head and tie on either side
