## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut the newspaper into strips (30cm x 5cm)
- 2. Starting at the corner of the strip, use the toothpick to roll the paper diagonally, keeping it tight. When rolling has started remove the toothpick and add a tiny blob of glue at the end to secure it. Repeat until you have made lots of straws.



3. Flatten each straw by running your finger along the straw. Place small dots of glue along the straw. Roll the straw tightly into a coil. If needed, glue more straws on the end. You need different sized coils, 1cm-3cm.



- 4. Place clingfilm in the bowl.
- 5. Using the method above make one large coil, approximately 10cm and put the large coil in the bowl to make the base. Next, use glue to firmly press a smaller coil to the base. Build up the rest of the sides by gluing coils of different sizes up the sides. Add more glue to the joints to strengthen the bowl.



6. Leave to harden. Glue layers of tissue paper to the inside of the bowl.



7. Remove the bowl from the clingfilm and paint the outside.
